PROTECTING ENDANGERED WILDLIFE

Summer is the breeding season for Hooded Plovers found along Collendina, RAAF's, 13th and Breamlea Beaches.

These vulnerable shorebirds need our help to successfully raise their chicks:

- walk on the wet sand near the water
- keep dogs on leads in designated areas
- follow guidance on beach signage.

IMPROVING COASTAL ACCESS

From beach to trail, we're enhancing your coastal connections this summer. Visit our newest beach stairs at 13th Beach "The Hole" (emergency marker TH1139), while works at Wedge Street, Ocean Grove commence February 2025.

For those heading out on the water, check out the upgraded Port of Barwon Heads facilities, including new navigation beacons and real-time conditions via the Boating VIC App.

The Blyth Street West coastal path in Breamlea has been transformed into a smooth, accessible track, making coastal walks and bike rides more enjoyable for everyone.
